

Hello,

The goal of this last FAQ is to make some points of the rules more accurate, according to the remarks made during the first Eurobot<sup>open</sup> qualification rounds.

**Important notice for the teams :**

Robots visual enhancement: All partner's logos are allowed, as long as their dimensions and positions don't obstruct or disturb others robots. Logos and labels shall be in accordance with the French EVIN law. Advertising for alcohol and tobacco is prohibited.

***Starting area of the robots :***

In its starting position, the robot shall be in contact with the in-goal bar (and not the in-goal coconut tree).

***Poster :***

To be approved, the team shall provide a poster which describe an interesting part of the robot (or the robot in full). This poster shall be designed to be easily understood. It shall be written in the native language of the team and, if possible, in English. The team shall provide the computer source of this poster to the referees during the approval phase. This file will be archived by Planète Sciences.

***Protection net:***

The protection net around the playing field is hold by metallic rods located only in the corners of the field.

***Schedule :***

As the number of teams is increasing over the years, it is highly recommended start the approval phase as early as possible. For the same reasons, special attention will be paid to the team's punctuality during the match phase.

***Drops :***

We remind you that only balls that remain into the net at the end of the match will score. No drop will be taken into account during the match time.

***Dimensions :***

Reminding : The height of the mast which support the beacon of the main robot is 53cm. This mast shall be put in the center of the robot.

Height of the horizontal goal bars (39 and 89cm) are measured from their lowest side, and not from their axis.
